

## Registration Guide 2018 – Lake of the Ozarks Porsche Parade

(March 30, 2018)

The 63rd Porsche Parade will be held at the Tan-Tar-A Resort in Osage Beach, Missouri Sunday July 8 – Saturday July 14, 2018. The Resort opened on July 4, 1960 with just 12 cottages overlooking the lakefront. Today it is 420 acres with a complete resort, hotel and estates. “Tan-Tar-A” is a Blackfoot Indian phrase meaning “one who moves swiftly”. There has been a previous Porsche Parade held at this location in August 1983.

Rules pertaining to the Parade and registering for the Parade are outlined in the Parade Competition Rules (PCRs). The 2018 PCRs are available on the Parade website ([www.porscheparade.org](http://www.porscheparade.org)).

### **Prior to Registering**

We encourage you to read through this registration document. It will help you to plan your events with your co-entrant before you register online.

Please ensure you have an account for the member only portion at [www.pca.org](http://www.pca.org). **YOU WILL NEED TO LOGIN TO REGISTER FOR PARADE.** Check to see that all your information is correct, that your car information is up-to-date and especially your email! A current contact phone number is also very important for Parade Week in case it is necessary to reach you. You will also want to be sure your cell phone number is correct—we will be using a texting app during Parade Week to receive event specific notifications and texts. All pre-Parade materials are sent to you via email, and/or are posted to the Parade website at [www.porscheparade.org](http://www.porscheparade.org).

Before you register, at the very least, you will want to know:

- Your meal selections
- Volunteer selections and T-shirt sizes for volunteers
- Competitive event selection for each participant, and the class for each event
- Birthdates of all children attending
- Do you want to participate in any tours or other special events?
- If your co-entrant is another PCA member who is not your supplementary member, you will need to know their membership number
- The license plate of the Porsche(s) you are bringing, along with the brand of tires

### **Registration**

Phase 2 (Banquets/Events) Registration for the 2018 Porsche Parade opens on Monday, April 02 at 12 Noon EDT. All registrations will be accepted but be aware some events fill quickly and then go to a “waitlist” status (it is clearly indicated on your registration, as well as the event fee. If the waitlist does not clear prior to registration close on June 10, you will receive a refund for that event).

When you register online, you must pay with an American Express, MasterCard or VISA in US funds. If you cannot register online, please call Kathleen Behrens at 503.579.3423 (PDT) to schedule a time to complete your registration after April 10, 2018.

All fees paid will be recorded and deposited at the time of registration.

Parade registrations are not transferable. Fifty percent (50%) of your registration fee and 100% of your banquet and event fees will be refunded if your emailed cancellation request to the Parade Registrar ([registrar@pcaparade.org](mailto:registrar@pcaparade.org)) is received on or before June 10, 2018. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR CANCELLATIONS MADE AFTER JUNE 10.** You may make changes to your registration at any time prior to June 10, 2018.

Registrations received after May 27 but up to and including June 10 will be assessed a \$60 late fee.

**Advance registration is mandatory—there is no onsite registration during Parade.**

### **Registration Fees**

Everyone signing up for the Parade must pay a registration fee of \$200, which covers the entrant and co-entrant. Entrants and co-entrants must be PCA members, but they need not be your supplementary member. This fee pays for your admittance to Parade, registration materials, one (1) Parade Bag, etc. Specific events may have additional fees. An entrant and co-entrant may each enter one car. Note that only Porsches as defined in the PCR's may be registered.

JPP/CAFP entrants:	\$25/each
Child age 13 – 15:	\$20/each
Child under age 13:	\$20/each
Adult Guests:	\$60/each
Late Entrant Fee:	\$60

JPP (Junior Participant Program) entrants are the sons, daughters, nieces, nephews and grandchildren of PCA members who are 16 or 17 years old. CAFPP (College-Aged Family Program) entrants are the sons, daughters, nieces, nephews and grandchildren of PCA members who are 18 – 25 years old.

Other guests are welcome; however, only the entrant, co-entrant and JPP/CAFP entrants may enter the competitive events (except children ages 13 – 15 may register for the Technical Quiz). If other guests are PCA Members, they must submit their own registration and pay their own registration fee to enter the competitive events.

Competitive Event Fees:

\$40/per <b>Porsche</b> for Concours
\$40/per <b>driver</b> for Autocross
\$15/per <b>person</b> for Tech Quiz
\$25/per <b>Porsche</b> for TSD Rally

## **Check-In**

Registrants should check-in for Parade on Sunday, July 8 between the hours of 9 AM and 3 PM in the Salons at Tan-Tar-A Resort (**no admittance after 3 PM**). This is the only time all the event chairs will be together to answer your questions as well as ensure you and your car are correctly classified for the competitive events. At Check-In you will have an opportunity to select seats for the two formal banquets if you haven't done so already, receive your name badges (required for entrance to all the activities) and obtain your Parade Bag.

**Onsite Check-In is mandatory before participation in events, and there are deadlines for checking in prior to the competitive events.** While limited late check-in is available during the week, the most fulfilling Parade experience begins with checking in on Sunday—and missing a deadline may mean you will not be able to compete. See the Parade Competition Rules for details.

## **Banquet Tickets**

Select the banquets you wish to attend when you register, or any time prior to June 10. You may purchase a package for all the meals/food related events or you may purchase each individually. The package does not include children's (age 12 and under) meals, which must be purchased individually.

Vegetarian and special dietary needs meals will be available by special request.

## **Competitive Events**

### **TSD Rally**

Entrants, along with any other entrant or co-entrant, may participate in the Rally in any street-legal Porsche that is registered for the Parade.

### **Concours**

Only the Porsche registered for Parade by the entrant or co-entrant may compete in the Concours.

### **Autocross**

All Porsches entered in the Autocross must pass the Parade Autocross Safety Inspection. Entrants, co-entrant, JPP and CAFP entrants must drive the Porsches they have registered for the Parade, unless otherwise allowed by the PCRs.

### **Tech Quiz**

Any entrant, co-entrant, registered child ages 13 – 15, JPP or CAFP entrant may compete in the Tech Quiz.

## Banquets

Banquets will be held onsite at Tan-Tar-A with one offsite at the Performance Boat Center. As usual, there also will be two “open” evenings where you can enjoy a nice selection of options available at the resort, the surrounding countryside or consider taking a dinner cruise on the Lake.

Concours and Victory banquet attendees will be pre-assigned at tables by regions. Small regions will be grouped with another region from their own zone to the extent possible. You will not need to go to the Banquet Seating Assignment Station during Check-In. If you prefer the “traditional” manner for seat/tablemate selection (you will need to go to the Banquet Seating Assignment Station during Check-In), be sure to check the box when completing your online registration.

**Sunday July 8 – Pirelli Welcome Party:** The Welcome Party will be held outdoors at the Hidden Lakes Golf Course (weather permitting). The Buffet menu will feature Whole Hogs served with assorted Barbeque Sauces; House made Sweet and Russet Potato Chips; Nacho Station served with Jalapenos, Diced Onion, Pico de Gallo, Black Olives, Sour Cream, Green Onions, Pulled Beef with Black Beans, Pulled Fajita Chicken; Jalisco Shrimp (Medium Shrimp with Avocado, Onion, Tomato, Cilantro and Sweet Mango; Bavarian Pretzel sticks served with House made Boulevard Cheese Sauce, Dijon and Yellow Mustards; all Beef Corn Dogs served with Ketchup and Yellow Mustard; Grilled All Beef Hot Dogs served with Creamy Cole Slaw and condiments to include Ketchup, Yellow Mustard, Pickle Relish and Caraway Sauerkraut; Fruit Kabobs and Marinated Cubed Fruit served with Vanilla Infused Whipped Cream, Granny Smith Caramel Apple Bites, House made Pies; S’mores with Assorted Chocolates, Brownies and Blondies; Fresh Watermelon along with Coffee, Decaf, Iced Tea, Iced Water. Cash Bars will be available. NOTE: The Welcome Party isn’t over until we say it is over! Right after the program we’ve got a big surprise for everyone attending! Open Seating. **Tuesday, July 10 – Porsche Concours Banquet:** The Grand Ballroom will celebrate the winners of the Concours d’ Elegance. The menu will match the evening starting with a Caprese Salad with Fresh Tomatoes, Mozzarella Pearls, Pesto Vinaigrette on Field Greens sprinkled with Sea Salt and feature a dual entrée of Sherry Braised Beef and Pacific White Fish in Lemon Cream Sauce; Yukon Gold Mashed Potatoes; Roasted Vegetables; Rolls and Butter; Amaretto Cheesecake with Raspberry Coulis or Godiva Cheesecake with Bailey’s Irish Cream (alternating plate side); Coffee, Decaf, Iced Tea, Iced Water. Vegetarian Option: Grilled Vegetable Napoleons (Grilled Zucchini, yellow squash, eggplant, portabella mushrooms, red onions, fresh basil and an herbed Basmati rice paired with a vegetable Demi-glace and a roasted Roma tomato. Cash Bars will be available. Award Presentation: Concours Awards and PCA National Awards. Reserved Seating: You will be able to choose pre-assigned region tables during online registration OR you can choose your own seat and tablemates during Check-In on Sunday, July 8. Dress: Business Casual. Cost: \$65 adults.

**Wednesday, July 11 – Mobil 1 Rally Banquet:** The Performance Boat Center will be front and center for this Banquet and will pay tribute to the Rally winners. **Due to extremely limited parking at The Performance Boat Center, there will be shuttle service available from the Resort.** The Buffet will feature Spinach Artichoke Dip; Tomato, Onion, Cucumber Salad; Herb Roasted Potatoes; Roasted Summer Vegetables, Baked Salmon with Dill Crust; Roast Prime Ribs of Beef (carved); Cheesecake Tarts and Chocolate Cake; Coffee, Decaf, Iced Tea, Iced Water. Cash Bars will be available. Award Presentation: TSD Rally Awards, National Newsletter Awards and National Website Awards. Open Seating. Dress: Casual. Cost: \$55 adults/\$25 children age 6 -12; age 5 and under no charge.

**Friday, July 13 – Michelin Autocross Banquet:** The Arrowhead Deck at Tan-Tar-A (weather permitting) will be the backdrop for this banquet. Our Traditional German Buffet includes Mixed Field Greens Salad with Tomatoes and Cucumbers served with Ranch, Italian, and Dill Vinaigrette Dressings; German Potato Salad with Bacon and Onions; Assorted Deviled Eggs; Sauerbraten with Aromatic Vegetables; Mixed Grill to include Brats, Knackwurst, Smoked Pork Chops and Pork Belly served with Kraut Munich Schnitzel served with Button Mushroom Sauce; Browned Russet Potatoes with Vidalia Onions; Herb Spätzle with Whole Grain Mustard; Sweet and Savory Blaukraut; German-style Vegetables; Rolls and Butter; Apple Dumplings, Linzer Torte; Apple, Walnut and Date Strudel; Coffee, Decaf, Iced Tea and Iced Water. Cash Bars will be available. Award Presentation: Autocross Awards, Parade Kids Recognition, Art Show Awards, Gimmick Rally Awards and PCA Regional Membership Award. Open Seating. Dress: Casual. Cost: \$55 adults/\$25 children age 6 – 12; age 5 and under no charge.

**Saturday, July 14 – Reliable Carriers Victory Banquet:** For the Grand Finale event, we revisit the Grand Ballroom at Tan-Tar-A Resort. The 65th Porsche Parade location will be revealed and we will hear from our PCA President. The annual winner for the “Trip to Germany” prize will be chosen. The menu highlights are a Farmers Spinach Salad, Dual Entrée of 4-oz Filet Mignon served with Cognac Peppercorn Sauce/Sea Bass with White Wine Sauce; Creamy Yukon Gold Mashed Potatoes; French Green Beans with Julienne Carrots and Red Bell Peppers; Sister Schubert Yeast Rolls and Butter; Bananas Foster Cake/Chocolate Caramel Pecan Cake (alternating plate side); Coffee, Decaf, Iced Tea, Iced Water. Vegetarian Option: Roasted Vegetables; Confetti Rice; Roasted Red Pepper Sauce paired with Grilled Portobello, Quinoa, Asparagus and Stewed Leeks. Cash Bars will be available. Award Presentation: President’s Parade Trophy, Parade Long Distance Award, PCA Public Service Award, and Historical and Technical Quiz Awards. Reserved Seating: You will be able to choose pre-assigned region tables during online registration OR you can choose your own seat and tablemates during Check-In on Sunday, July 8. Dress: Business Casual. Cost: \$60 adults.

Vegetarian alternatives are available for the two plated meals--Concours and Victory Banquets. Order these, or list any other special dietary requests, when you complete online registration.

There will be a Concours box lunch available at the Hidden Lakes Golf Course for your picnicking pleasure on Monday, July 9 with these sandwich options: Ham & Swiss; Turkey & Cheddar; or Garden Vegetable. All include of bag of Kettle chips, packets of mayonnaise and mustard, Whole Fresh Fruit, cookies, along with a choice of a canned soft drink or bottled water. Dress: Very Casual. Cost: \$20.

Last minute scheduling changes for Parade Week are announced at the banquet closest to the event affected.

Trophies are not shipped and need to be picked up at the event banquet or at the Information Desk in Hospitality through Friday afternoon.

**Remember, to be eligible for an evening’s door prizes,** you must register for that banquet and be present to win!

The Banquet Meal Package (includes the five evening banquets and Concours box lunch) price is \$295— a savings of \$20 over purchasing individually.

### **Porsche Concours d' Elegance – Monday, July 9 (\$40 per car)**

This is the premiere Porsche Parade competition event. This year, the Concours d' Elegance will be held on the picturesque 1<sup>st</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> fairways of the Hidden Lakes Golf Course at the Tan-Tar-A Resort. Concours will host over 200 Concours Porsches, including the Heritage & Historic Display of unique and rare Porsches. Class Awards will be presented on the Concours Field. Group and Level of Achievement Awards will be presented at the Concours Banquet. Be sure to review the 2018 Parade Competition Rules prior to registration to determine the correct judging class in which your Porsche should be entered.

Indoor Concours Prep will be in a secure and enclosed area in the underground Parking Garage of Building A at the Resort. This facility will be available starting Friday, July 6 at 8 am on a first-come first-served basis. Electrical outlets are plentiful and it is recommended you should be prepared to have an additional light source. The Car Wash area is in the parking lot adjacent to the Hidden Lakes Golf Pro Shop.

- “Concours 101” is a one-hour technical session focused primarily for new or aspiring Concours entrants. The briefing includes protocol, rules, what to expect and some helpful preparation techniques along with handouts. The two sessions during the week are scheduled for Saturday July 7 at 5 pm and Sunday July 8 at 7 am in the Redbud Meeting Room, Building A of the Resort.

### **TSD Rally – Tuesday, July 10 (\$25 per car)**

The TSD Rally will take you around the scenic roads surrounding the Lake of the Ozarks area in a rally sharpened for your driving pleasure. It will delight the novice and challenge the rally experts! It will take about four hours to run including breaks (gas and restrooms) and spans approximately 110 miles. You will be back in time for the start of the traditional ice cream social! Whether you have never rallied before or just want a refresher, be sure to attend the TSD Rally School on Monday, July 9. Our TSD Rally School is designed for the novice and taught by past TSD Rally champions. You will learn about the rally, what to bring, tips for staying on time, along with rally generals (the rules of the event and how to use them), terminology, how to fill out a score sheet and what to do at a checkpoint (control).

**Only the entrant or co-entrant who is bringing the rally Porsche should register for the rally. Parade Guests are not allowed to compete in this event.** The “PCA Juniors” program is different from PCA JPP—and those under the age of 16 are not allowed to participate. Status of entrants for the TSD Rally will be verified. If you are driving or navigating another Parade entrant’s Porsche, the other entrant must register for the rally and include your name on their rally registration. Junior Participation Program (JPP) members may not drive in the Rally but may navigate with either of their sponsoring PCA member driving. College Age Family Program (CAFP) members may either drive or navigate in the rally. Be sure to see the current Parade Competition Rules (PCRs) for definitions of the current rally classes offered (with the addition of a new Tech Equip Rally Class, there are now six). The use of GPS Navigation systems (both factory and portable) has been clarified. **Entrants are responsible for classifying their own vehicle.**

### **Michelin Autocross – Wednesday and Thursday, July 11 and 12 (\$40 per person)**

The Autocross will be held at Camdenton Regional Airport, approximately 13 miles from Parade Central. Once again, it is scheduled for two days allowing plenty of time for all who want to participate.

The Autocross area is roughly 200' x 800' of a very new repaved surface. In order to ensure a fun time for the many less experienced entrants that attend Parade, the course will be easy to follow and emphasize flow. Watch the Parade website for comments on the course and site conditions.

Set aside 3:30 – 5:30 pm on Tuesday, July 10 for the Autocross Chalk Talk and course walk at the Autocross site--there will be an analysis of the course and a chance to learn tips and techniques. The course will also be open on Wednesday, July 11 from 7:30 – 8:30 am and after runs are completed for the day (around 3 pm) and on Thursday, July 12 from 7:30 – 8:30 am for course walks.

All Porsches entered in the Autocross must pass the Parade Safety Technical Inspection. The Safety Inspection will be done at the Autocross site on Grid from 7 – 9 am/11 am – 2 pm on both Autocross days. Please take a few minutes to look at the PCA Tech Inspection form on the Parade website prior to arriving at Parade to ensure you are in compliance! If you are competing in Autocross, you are responsible for all items on the Safety Inspection form prior to your run group.

Registered Junior Participation Program (JPP) members and College Age Family Program (CAFP) members with a valid driver's license may participate in the autocross in the same Porsche and same as the parent(s).

The run schedule for Wednesday will be all Improved cars in morning; all Modified cars in the afternoon. Some Production cars may run in the afternoon (GT3's/GT4's) as well. Showroom Stock cars (S01 – S13) as well as the Production (P01 – P15) on Thursday. Check the Parade website for additional details.

Study the PCRs to determine the proper autocross class to enter. There are separate classes for men and for women, so be sure to choose appropriately. Be aware there is an Open Class and a Ladies Class—women can choose which class they wish to run in. **It is your responsibility to correctly classify your Porsche.**

### **Gimmick Rally – Thursday, July 12 (\$20 per car)**

“Get Your Kicks on Route 66!” This rally will take you on a journey down memory lane—a road trip on the iconic “Route 66”. You will have a full day of Americana--Missouri style! Bring your camera, your curiosity and your appetite too, for a true “bucket-list” day! And don't forget, you will find all the clues to solve your gimmick rally challenge along the way.

This rally will provide plenty of opportunities for sight-seeing, photos, eats and drinks along with a road trip of American heritage and history.

Total rally time is a minimum of six hours including stops.

During Parade Check-In, you will choose your competition class (either Two-Person or Two-Plus Passengers) depending upon the number of people in your vehicle (**minimum of two**). You may enter as a pair, a family or join in with friends; and **you may drive a Porsche, rental car, tow vehicle or “other” but it must have as many seat belts as passengers**. You also can change your class if your plans change during Parade Week. **ONLY the DRIVER should register for this event.**

**NOTE: PCA insurance restrictions prohibit participation by anyone who is NOT registered for Parade. Thus, you cannot have a friend or family member, adult or minor, “ride along” unless they are registered. There will be no exceptions.**

### **Technical and Historical Quiz – Friday, July 13 (\$15 per person)**

The Technical and Historical Quiz will be a written test of your knowledge of general, mechanical, and historic aspects of the Porsche family, business and model lines. You will be able to test your knowledge with questions from the PCA Tech Committee.

There will be 50 General questions that will be the same of all participants, 25 additional questions for Specific Model Ranges (you choose which model) and 5 Tiebreaker questions for everyone that will NOT count in your score but will only be used to settle tie scores if they occur. For the Overall Awards the score will be weighted toward the General History and Technical questions; for the Model Specific Awards the score will be weighted toward the Model Specific questions.

The questions will be multiple choice and true/false. The bibliography of publications used for the questions will be posted on the Parade website two months prior to Parade. Allotted Quiz Time: 90 minutes.

### **Art Show (\$20 per adult/Children under 12 no charge)**

All Parade entrants who are artists, crafters and Porsche aficionados are invited to participate in the Art Show at Lake of the Ozarks—what a great opportunity to share your creative side with other Parade attendees. There are 17 categories you can choose from, based on your experience and expression. Seasoned judges select the leading achievements in each category, besides the Best of Show and People’s Choice Awards. Art Show Entrants will be honored with a Wine and Cheese Reception.

Complete guidelines, rules and entrant application will be available on the Parade website.

### **Volunteers**

Volunteers are the formula to make the Parade a success—you help to make this extraordinary week run smoothly. In fact, our Parade is 99% volunteer supported! Every Parade event needs volunteers and volunteering is a wonderful way to meet other PCA members and to share in the fun and energy of Parade.

By volunteering to work at the Parade, you will receive a specially designed shirt to be worn while you work. When you complete a shift, please have your Volunteer Worker card stamped. A shift is between 3 to 6 hours, normally a morning (AM), mid-day (MD) or an afternoon (PM) shift. Work two shifts and you will be qualified to attend the Volunteer Party luncheon on Saturday, July 14 which includes a great lunch (Caesar Salad with Garlic Croutons/ Shredded Parmesan Cheese; Penne Primavera; Baked Ziti

Bolognese topped with Mozzarella Cheese; Seasoned Corn with Red Peppers; Garlic Bread Sticks; Assorted Cookies and Brownies; Iced Tea and Iced Water), time for socializing, and door prizes! It is a thank-you for being a Parade Volunteer Worker as a registered entrant! Children 14 years of age and over can volunteer for most events with the permission of their parents and at the discretion of the event chair.

General description of responsibilities within each event:

**5K Run/Walk:** Assist with setup, ensure participants stay on course, post-event cleanup.

**Art Show:** Help receive and secure artwork, write receipts, and monitor the room. Remove displays and close out the Art Show at the end of the event.

**Autocross:** Set up the course, grid, work course, assist timing/scoring, handout supplies, assist final tech, control traffic, and post-event cleanup.

**Banquets:** Set up and decorate for the banquets, take tickets, post-event cleanup.

**Car Wash:** Maintain car wash areas supplies.

**Concours:** Field layout, car placement, field marshals, traffic control, runners/timers, scoring, post event-cleanup.

**Concours Prep:** Assist with organizing car cleaning area for Concours participants and general Parade participants.

**Driving Tours:** Driving Tours Leaders, Driving Tour Sweepers, and Bus Tour Marshals needed.

**Equipment:** Assist with delivery, placement and collection of supplies for events and post-event cleanup.

**Gimmick Rally:** Assist at start tent, collect score sheets, scoring.

**Parade Store:** Setup/take down displays, cash register checkout, counter help, sales help, stocking, inventory, door duty, packing, post-event cleanup.

**Heritage and Historic Display:** Car placement and monitor the participants viewing the classic street/racing cars.

**Hospitality:** Greet/assist entrants, provide information, and serve snacks/drinks.

**Michelin Drive and Compare:** Assist with course setup, work grid/corners, traffic control and post-event cleanup.

**Parade Check-In:** Check-in registered entrants, work at various event stations, handout Parade bags, assign banquet seating.

**Parade Info Desk:** Answer questions and direct participants.

**Parade Kids:** Assist in setup and running of Parade Kid activities. Background Check required; details on Parade Kids and Volunteers on the Parade website.

**Parking Control:** Direct vehicles to correct parking/staging areas.

**RC Car Race:** Assist with course setup, event management and post-event cleanup.

**Safety/Tech Inspection:** Perform Autocross safety checks.

**Technical Quiz:** Greet entrants, handout quiz, monitor, quiz collection, scoring.

**Tech Sessions:** Assist speakers, monitor/work AV equipment, help with refreshments.

**TSD Rally:** Checkpoint/control workers, starting, finishing, staging, scoring.

**Water/Ice:** Assist with delivery for events.

**Welcome Tent:** Greet/assist entrants as they arrive.

### **Parade Kids (\$30 additional fee per child)**

2018 Parade Kids promises to be exciting! There are many things to do at the Tan-Tar-A Resort and lots of activities planned—all kids and juniors are welcome to join in accompanied by their parents.

### **Driving Tours**

**All driving tours will stage and depart from Camdenton High School, approximately 12 miles from Tan-Tar-A Resort. Note: Some of these tours stage/depart early due to destination tour/lunch start times.**

- **Warm Springs Ranch/Les Bourgeois Winery (Tuesday July 10, Wednesday July 11, Thursday July 12 and Friday July 13)** – Approximately 92 miles, 5 hours including lunch tour time (return trip on your own), entrant limit of 130 people per day (split into two start times), \$50 per adult/\$35 per child age 12 and under for Buffet/\$30 per child age 12 for an alternative menu. Includes tour at Warm Springs Ranch and lunch at Les Bourgeois Winery.
